

GMA Policy Committee Membership Form

Elected & Appointed City Officials

GMA's six standing committees serve as forums for members to hear about the status of legislative and policy issues and as channels for advancing recommendations to the GMA Legislative Policy Council (LPC), a 30-member body appointed by the GMA President. These committees meet once during Mayors' Day and once during GMA's convention in June.

At the June meeting, the LPC submits a draft legislative agenda to the six committees, based on an assessment of statewide issues and input received at district meetings across the state. The committees review and return their recommendations to the LPC which is then responsible for developing a final proposed legislative agenda for presentation to the GMA membership for approval. The January meeting occurs during the legislative session and the policy committees are primarily briefed to assist with lobbying efforts at the state capitol.

Policy Committees meet during two time blocks, three committees at a time, as grouped in the columns below. City officials can join one committee per block. Cities are encouraged to coordinate assignment of representatives who join the committees to achieve the broadest possible committee coverage.
